A4S/00179, Harborne, Moor Pool Avenue Flood Alleviation. Project Information.

Further to your letter dated 12th September, I write to provide information regarding proposed improvements to the capacity of the foul sewer system on the Moor Pool Estate.

On 18th September, Severn Trent Water's Programme Board approved funding to progress a scheme which will alleviate flooding to properties in The Circle, Moor Pool Avenue and provide improved sewer capacity for Banner Homes' valley development off Ravenhurst Road.

The solution requires provision of a new foul sewer in Park Edge, upsizing a section of existing foul sewer in Ravenhurst Road and provision of a storage tank below allotment gardens within Banner Homes' Valley development site.

We are shortly to begin 'Stage 2' of the scheme which will include advanced feasibility, site investigation, land, planning and customer consultations. 'Stage 4' – construction could commence as early as February 2013 to correspond with Banner Homes programme. Stages 2-4 will be undertaken by Enterprise who are Severn Trent's design and build partner.
